



## The Nocatee Farmers Market FAQ Sheet

**When is the Nocatee Farmers Market?** The Nocatee Farmers Market is the third Saturday of every month from 10:00am-1:00pm.

**What is the average attendance of the market?** 2,000-5,000 attendees throughout the day.

**What sets this market apart from others?** The Nocatee Farmers Market takes enormous pride in setting itself apart, and getting bigger and better each month. A unique theme and event is planned for every month such as a BMX-Treme Extravaganza, Spring Fling, Wildlife Encounters, etc. These events are proving to bring in an enormous crowd of attendees. **All vendors must sell a handmade/homemade food or craft item.**

**What do vendors need to provide?** Vendors need to provide their own table, chairs, 12x12 pop-up tent, and weights to secure your tent.

**Is electricity available?** Limited power is available along one vendor row. It is designated for food vendors only.

**Any paperwork or Licenses required?** Yes, we require all vendors that are chosen to participate to fill out our standard Vendor Agreement Form every three months. We also need a copy of your Business License, preferably St. Johns County. Food vendors are required to provide a copy of your Business License AND food handler's permit. Hannah will send you the Vendor Agreement if you are chosen to participate.

**Is there a cost to be a vendor?** Yes, we require vendors to pay a flat rate of \$75 to participate in each yearly quarter, covering 3 markets. 1st Quarter = January, February, March. 2nd Quarter = April, May, June. 3rd Quarter = July, August, September. 4th Quarter = October, November, December. Payments are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
